Let's make Hoot Owl's final costume disguise and a mouth-watering pizza!



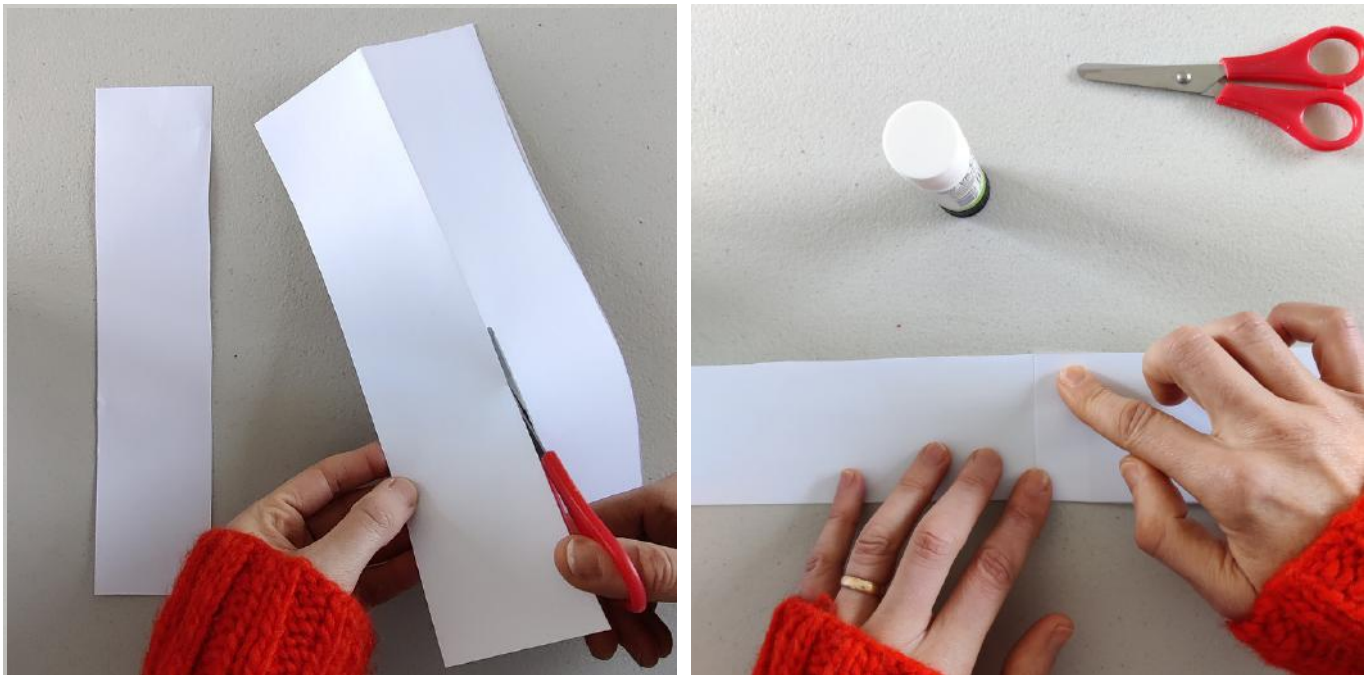
Chef's Paper Hat



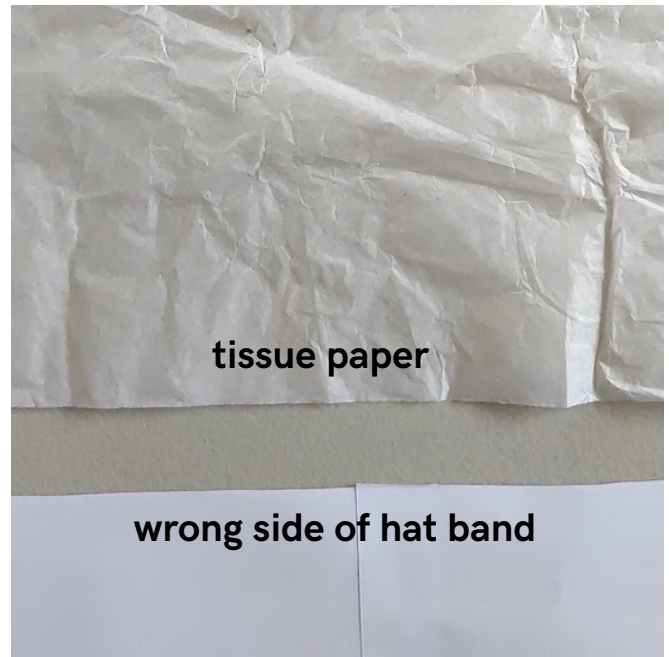
You will need:

- A4 sheet of white paper or card
- white tissue paper (mine came from packaging for new shoes)
- scissors
- coloured felt pens
- glue
- stapler

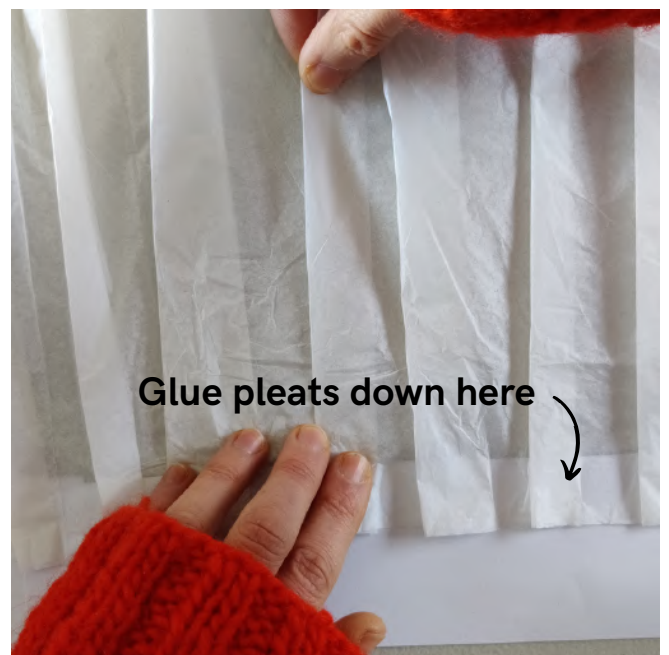
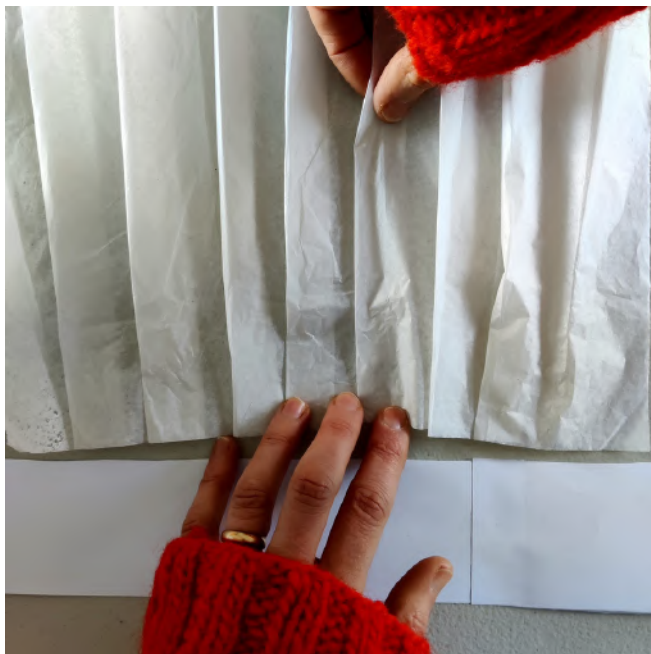
How to make:



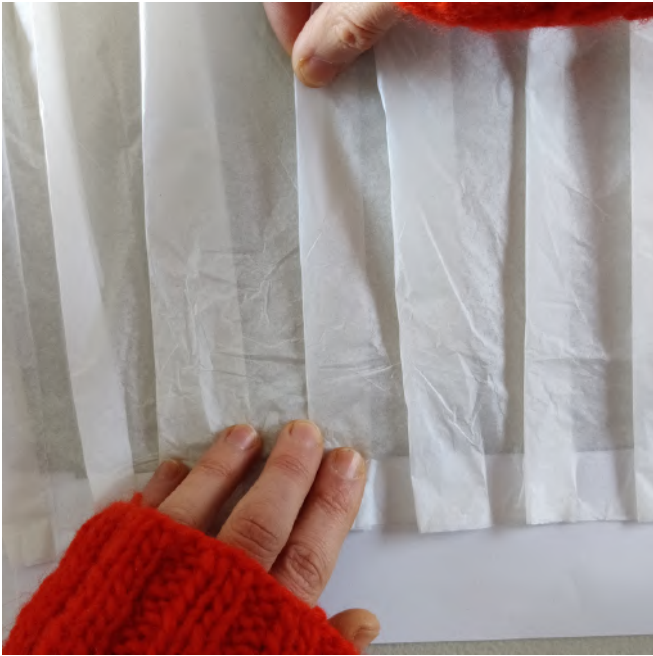
1. Fold the paper/card into 3 parts lengthways. Cut along each fold.
2. Stick 2 of the cut lengths together to create the hat band.



- 3. Decorate one side of the hat band.**
- 4. Line up the bottom of the tissue paper with the top of the wrong (undecorated) side of the hat band.**



- 5. Create pleats in the tissue paper until it is the same length as the band. You can always stick 2 pieces of tissue paper together if you need extra length or leave out the pleats if you don't have enough tissue paper.**
- 6. Glue the bottom of the pleats down to secure them.**



- 7.** Glue along the top of the wrong side of the hat band and press the bottom edge of the pleated tissue paper to it.
- 8.** Glue one vertical side of the hat - along the hat band and tissue paper.



- 9.** Roll the glued end round to stick it to the other side of the hat, measuring your child's head so it fits nicely. They will need to be wear their costume when you measure to ensure the hat will be big enough.
- 10.** Push the open top of the tissue paper to the inside of the hat.



- 11.** From the inside of the hat, scrunch the ends of the tissue paper together and staple them.
- 12.** Push the tissue paper back up through the inside and reshape the top of the hat as shown.
