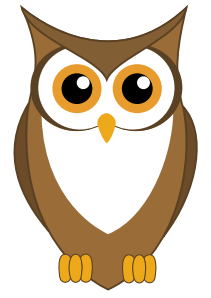




The House at Pooh Corner



'WOL' name badge and Cardboard Sign for The Wolery

Let's make a name badge for
Winnie-the-Pooh's friend, Owl, and a sign for
owl's house in 100 Aker Wood, called
'The Wolery'!

'WOL' name badge



You will need:

- empty cereal box
- pencil
- scissors
- sticky tape
- black marker
- birthday badges*

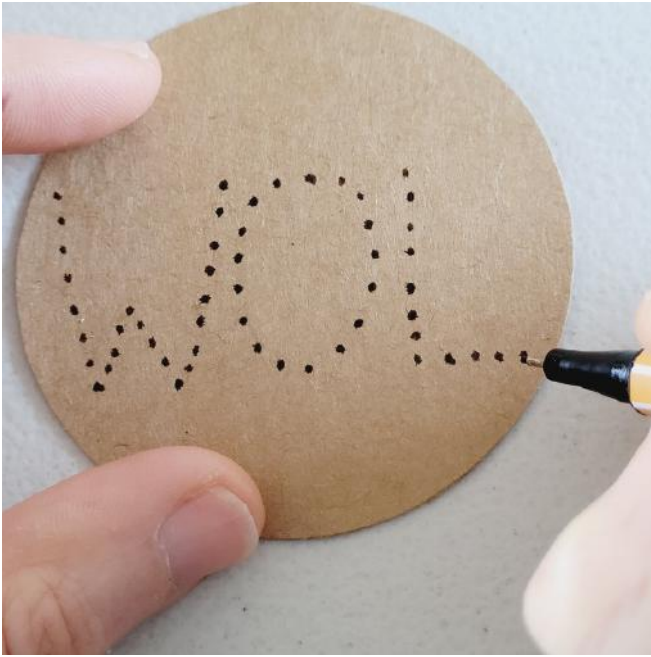
*Have a look to see if you have any birthday badges lying around the home (the ones you often get with children's birthday cards), they are perfect for reusing - just stick the card name onto them.



How to make:



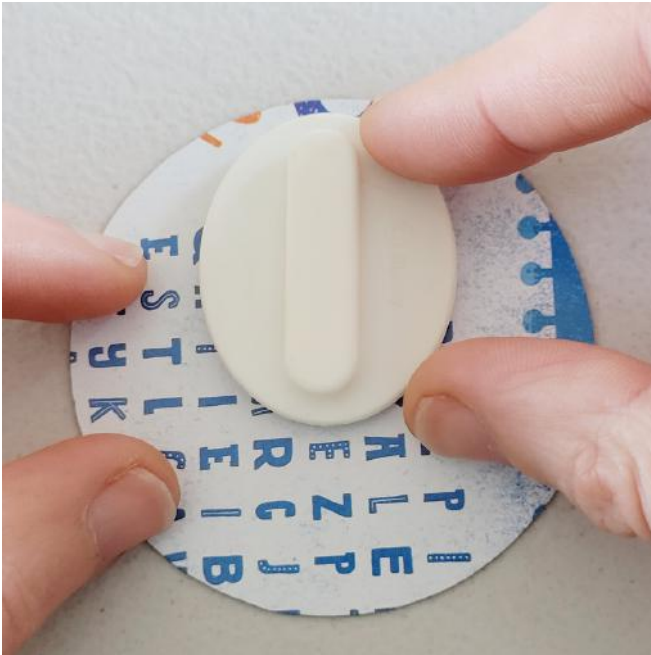
1. Draw a circle approximately 6cm in diameter onto the cereal box. I used a little tub but you could just draw a circle freehand.
2. Cut the circle out.



3. Write the name WOL on the circle. For younger children you could write the name in dots and they join the dots up. It's a fun way of involving them in the making!
4. Now join up the dots!



5. Make a loop of sticky tape by wrapping the non-sticky side of sticky tape around your finger. Cut the tape.
6. Slide it off your finger and press it onto the front of the birthday badge.



7. Press the birthday badge onto the back of the cardboard name circle, positioning it in the middle towards the top edge.
8. Make sure the name is the right way round when you turn it over!
