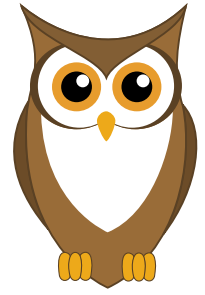




The Gruffalo



Owl Ice Cream

Let's make The Gruffalo's
favourite food!



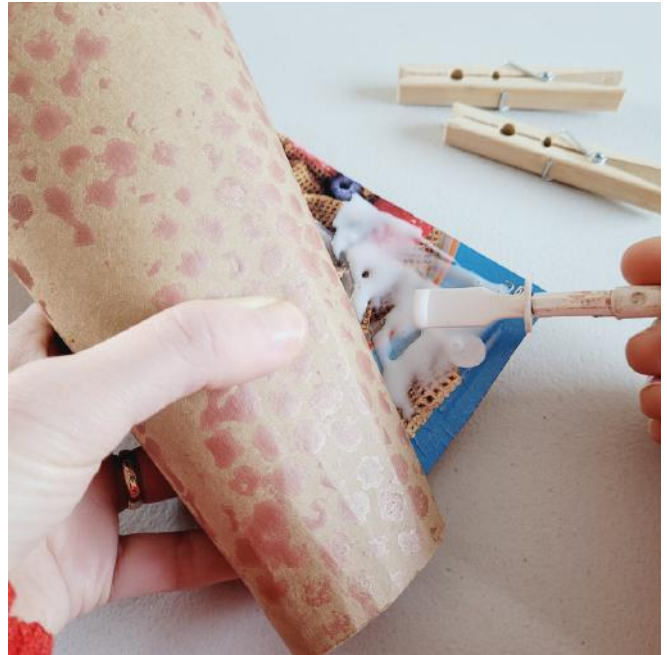
You will need:

- empty cereal box
- pencil
- glue
- scissors
- brown paint & paint brush (optional)
- plastic container eg take-away box
- clothes peg
- bubble wrap or potato masher (optional)
- tissue paper or use bubble wrap covered with a layer of tissue paper
- pompoms/buttons/ glitter
- black marker
- coloured felt pens

How to make:



1. Cut out the front of a cereal box. Trim the edges to neaten them.
2. Pour some brown paint into a container eg a take-away box. Paint the base of the potato masher or bubble wrap with the paint and print onto the cereal box to create a cone pattern. Leave it to dry.



- 3. Curl the cereal box into an ice cream cone shape.**
- 4. Glue the cone shape in place.**



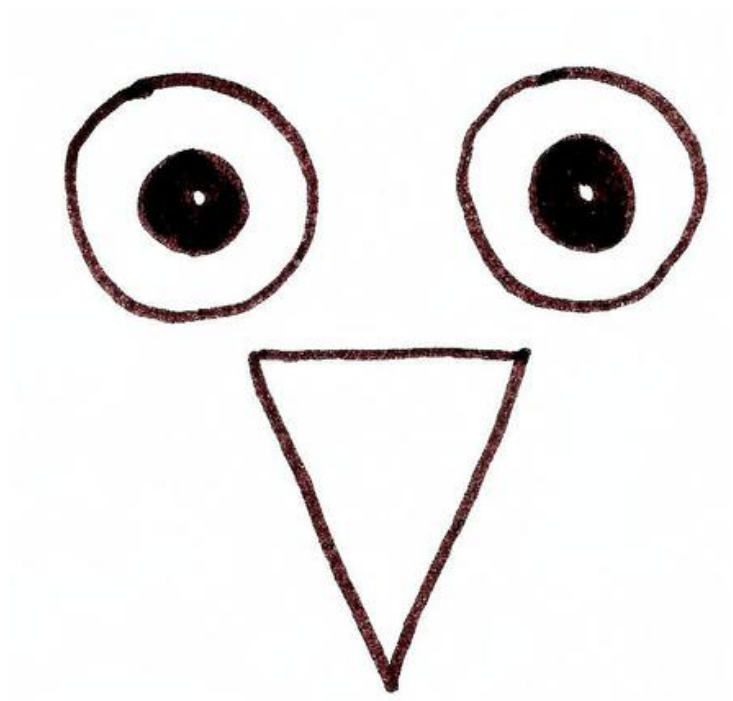
- 5. Use clothes pegs to hold the shape whilst the glue dries.**
- 6. Scrunch tissue paper/bubble wrap into a ball (a bit bigger than a tennis ball).**



- 7.** Cover with another layer of coloured tissue paper to make it smoother as will be easier to decorate.
Now glue the tissue ball inside the top of the cone.
- 8.** On the left over card from the cereal box, draw 2 owl eyes and a beak with a black marker. There's a template provided or draw your own. Colour in and cut out.



- 9.** Glue the eyes and beak in place as shown.
- 10.** Decorate your ice cream with little pompoms, buttons, glitter etc.
